Aims & Objectives

A dance based qualification with an emphasis on safety that promotes creativity and freedom of expression. Learners will gain insight in the industry including knowledge on moral and ethical dilemmas, to better prepare for next steps which might include further education or working in the industry.

Dance Styles Covered

Learners will develop knowledge & skills in Ballet, Contemporary, Jazz and Hip-Hop and will have the option of focusing on any dance style for the final project.

Delivery Methods

Whilst the qualification can be delivered face to face, distance learning is the main delivery method.

Target Group

The target group is pre-GCSE aged learners who are home educated, EOTAS or who school based learners looking to increase their qualification outside of their school curriculum.

Minimum Entry requirements

No prior qualifications are necessary but an interest in dance and performance arts would be beneficial.

Guidance and Support

Specialist tutor support is available online via email.

Assessment Method

The units are internally assessed and moderated and externally moderated.

Our qualification has been developed to meet the specific needs of our learners and has been accredited by NCFE demonstrating the quality and rigor.

NCFE is an awarding organisation recognised by the qualification regulators for England (Ofqual), Wales (Qualifications Wales) and Northern Ireland (CCEA Regulation).

This is an unregulated qualification and is not a nationally recognised qualification. This qualification has been accredited as a Customised Qualification and we have benchmarked the qualification's learning outcomes and assessment criteria at Level 2 (using a national framework's level descriptors) to allow you to demonstrate the difficulty and depth of study.

On completion of the Customised Qualification, learners will receive a certificate of achievement. The certificate is evidence of the knowledge and skills gained by completing the qualification. This qualification has been accredited by NCFE under the Customised Qualification and the certificate of achievement will be issued directly by NCFE.

In response to numerous requests by families to extend her reach, Home Edu-Stage is now collaborating with Technology Triumphs, in order to deliver Performance Art qualifications remotely.

Technology Triumphs is a multi award winning company, established since 2019, which was the first of its kind to offer creative qualifications specifically to the Home Educating community using a fully remote business model.

This collaboration means that learners will now have a wider choice of home based learning options in which to achieve certification.

Whilst Technology Triumphs acts as the Exam Centre for this qualification, Home Edu-Stage is the course creator and the sole provider of this qualification.

How it Works:

- Book direct with Home-Edu Stage.
- Complete the 5 modules of the fully remote course, working through pdf workbook with pre-filmed tutorials.
- Submit photographic, written and video evidence, with no deadlines.
- Receive bespoke feedback directly from Home Edu-Stage, on each Module.
- Address corrections or revisions as many times as you need to.
- Technology Triumphs internally moderates the work and assessment, and registers learners with NCFE.
- NCFE externally moderates the work.
- On successful completion, Technology Triumphs claim the certificates from NCFE and send on directly to the learners.

Assessment

When you/your learner, has completed a module, you can submit it via a simple and secure form, directly to your assessor.

These courses are assessed as a pass or fail rather than a graded qualification. However, feedback given after the Module submission will indicate how the learner is progressing through the learning objectives. More detailed and bespoke written feedback will also be provided.

Your Home Edu-Stage assessor will complete written feedback within 10 working days of your submission (during online periods). This will then be sent back to you via the email address you provide on your submission form.

There is no limit to the number of times that a learner can submit work and needing to complete corrections or additions has no negative outcome on the final result.

As well as highlighting areas of strength, written comments will be provided to enable you/your learner to develop and make improvements. Any work that needs to be revisited or developed in order to pass an assessment criteria, will be highlighted.

Support

This course has been designed to allow distance learning through pre-filmed tutorials with a 'light touch' input from an assessor. This is to ensure affordability for more families and to allow learners to develop their skills at their own pace. The tutorials and Modules will walk the learner through many of the processes and guide them with developing their skills and knowledge in able to complete the set work. Links to these videos are provided on each Pdf document and these have been created specifically for the courses. There may be some tasks that require the learner to complete independent research.

A dedicated Facebook page has been set up as a support group for participants. This is a platform whereby anyone registered with the course (or their parents) can join and share ideas or ask for further guidance. It is also be a great place to celebrate the work and request feedback from peers.

These pages are monitored however, as we are unable to monitor the groups on a 24/7 basis, parental discretion would be advised if allowing young learners to join the groups.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is this the same as a GCSE?

We cannot say that this is comparable to a GCSE.

If you are seeking to use this qualification for entry requirements, as with all Level 2 courses it is recommended that you speak directly to the admissions office of any prospective colleges to see if they will accept this qualification as part of their entry requirements.

It is worth noting, that as with most creative subjects, building a portfolio is particularly useful for gaining access to further education within the subject and this course is designed to enable learners to do that.

What if my circumstances change and we no longer want to continue with the course?

That is absolutely fine. We have designed the course with flexibility in mind and it can be cancelled at any point with no obligation for future payments. We also hold work on account for a period of 12 months should the learner wish to re register and pick up from where they left off with payments.

Is there a sibling discount?

Unfortunately not - Home Edu-Stage has been entirely self funded from the start and receives no government funding. The course fees cover the cost of registration and certification with the awarding body, as well as the assessor time needed to assess and feedback for each individual learner. Costs have been kept as low as possible to ensure as many families as possible are able to afford the provisions.

We want to complete in a year - is this possible?

Whilst this may be possible in the future, for 2026-27 intake, the course will run over a minimum of 2 years. This is to allow for course development.

What if my child needs more time?

This is absolutely fine - with no end point exams we can offer flexibility up to 12 months beyond the scheduled course finish date.

We don't use social media - is this a problem?

This is absolutely fine - there is no obligation to join the Facebook group, this is an additional support measure and is not required to access and complete the course.

The course doesn't work for us - can I get a refund?

Whilst the payment plan can be cancelled at any point - we cannot offer refunds on retrospective months due to the costs associated in managing the learner on the course.

I've finished earlier/later - do I pay less/more?

Total cost of the course remains the same no matter how long you take to complete -there is no penalisation for taking longer than your payment plan to complete.

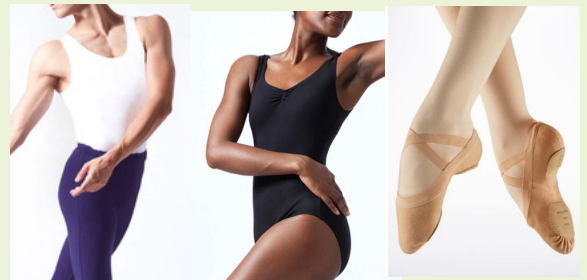

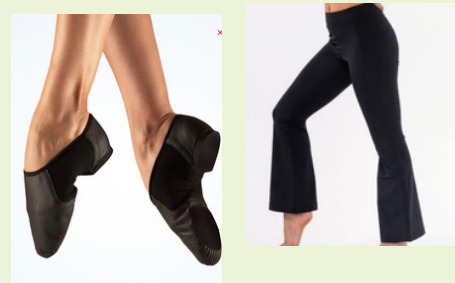

Pilot Scheme Rate

For September 2026 a pilot scheme a discounted rate will be applied. Our pilot scheme will be limited to the first 100 learners to register.

Total cost for the course, including registration and certification is £500.

This is payable in full or on a no obligation payment plan option as follows:
